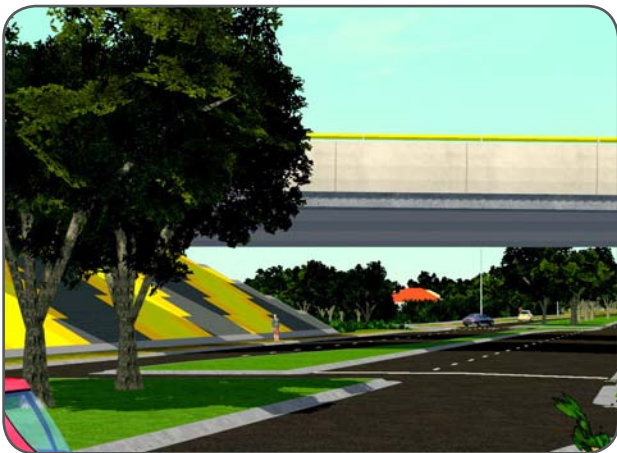

Baxter Construction Update

March 2011

Works are continuing to ramp up in Baxter and there will be a lot happening in the coming months. Here are some of the activities planned for your area.

Baxter-Tooradin Road and Frankston-Flinders Road, Baxter

Culverts are being installed to allow local waterways such as the Watson and Balcombe creeks to travel underneath the freeway. Service relocations in this area will be ongoing for the next two months.

Mornington Tourist rail line, Baxter

Piling works are complete and construction of the retaining walls is underway.

Piling works

Piling works for the bridges over Baxter-Tooradin and Frankston-Flinders roads are scheduled to commence in mid to late March. The piling works will create short term but substantial noise as the piles are hammered into the ground. Piling works are expected to last approximately four weeks.
