MOOROODUC CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

March 2011

Major construction works for the Peninsula Link project are continuing between Eramosa Road West and Old Moorooduc Road, Moorooduc. There will be an increase in construction vehicles and machinery working along and around the alignment. Piling works are underway and service relocations continue in preparation for major construction.

Earthworks

Major earthworks are continuing in the area between Mornington Tourist Rail, Baxter and Loders Road, Moorooduc. These works may involve moving topsoil from areas where Peninsula Link runs below existing ground level to areas where Peninsula Link will be raised. This earth will be predominantly moved from one location to another via haul roads along the freeway corridor. Top soil stripping and earthworks also continue in the area between the Loders Road and Old Moorooduc Road.

Heavy machinery is moving bridge abutments into place to facilitate construction of road bridges over Peninsula Link and local waterway crossings.

Derril Road

Backfilling over the Derril Road underpass has commenced and will be ongoing until mid to late March. This activity involves raising the surrounding ground level to build Peninsula Link over the top.

Piling works

Piling works continue in preparation for bridge construction over local waterways in the area between Bungower Road and Old Moorooduc Highway, Moorooduc. Piling works are expected to last approximately four weeks. The piling works will create short term but substantial noise as the piles are driven into the ground.

Service Relocations

Service relocations are continuing in the Moorooduc area in preparation for major construction activities. Utilities providers will contact residents in advance of any planned disruption to their services.
