## MOOROODUC CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

May 2011

Major construction works for the Peninsula Link project are continuing in the Moorooduc area with bridgeworks underway at Old Moorooduc, Eramosa, Bungower and Mornington-Tyabb roads and work soon to commence at Loders Road.

Earthworks to grade the freeway surface are making good progress with alignment of the roadway and entry and exit ramps now visible in most places. We have provided a snapshot of upcoming activities below and encourage you to phone us on 1300 453 035 if you would like further details.

### Traffic changes at Loders Road

Over the coming months, a temporary side track will be constructed just south of Loders Road to divert traffic around the Loders Road bridge and excavation site. Construction will commence on this side track in May and traffic is scheduled to be switched over onto the temporary alignment in June. We will keep the community informed about any overnight or weekend road closures that may be needed to switch the traffic onto the new side track.

### Southern Interchange

Barriers and new line markings have been placed on Moorooduc Highway to assist with upcoming traffic changes at the intersection of Moorooduc Highway, Mornington Peninsula Freeway and Old Moorooduc Road. These changes will come into effect in June and will require some temporary diversions around the site while we build this major interchange.

### Piling

Driven piling will occur in early May as part of bridge construction works associated with Balcombe Creek. These works will commence at the Mornington Tourist Rail (lasting approximately two weeks) and then at the Eramosa Road bridge in mid to late May (approximately two weeks). We expect these works to create short term but substantial noise as the piles are driven into the ground.

### Waterway crossings

Construction of the waterway crossings over the Devilbend, Tuerong and Balcombe Creeks are ongoing with form work and concrete pours to create the bridge and arch structures continuing throughout May.

### Mornington Tourist Rail

Construction of the bridge over the Mornington Tourist Rail Line is ongoing with 50 per cent of structural concrete poured.

### Beam lifts – Bungower Road

The first beams for the Bungower Road bridge are scheduled to be lifted in May. Following the placements of beams, work will commence on the deck concrete slab. Peninsula Link travels under Bungower Road.

### Earthworks

Major earthworks are continuing in the area between Mornington Tourist Rail in Baxter and Loders Road in Moorooduc.
